Theories of performativity have extended across multiple disciplines and importantly concerns the speaker's intentions regarding indirect speech acts, Introducing Performative Pragmatics, and non-literal contents. In Bach's words: Wide context concerns any contextual information relevant to determining the speaker's intention and to the successful and felicitous performance of the speech act... Narrow context concerns information specifically relevant to determining the semantic values of [indexicals]... Bach a Bach goes on to say, Narrow context is semantic, wide context pragmatic.
