The concept of the concentration camps was borrowed from the South African Boers. The region's other main tribe, the Nama, have risen in support of their traditional enemies, the Herero. The outbreak of hostilities in Europe in August had been anticipated and government officials of South Africa were aware of the significance of their common border with the German colony.
